

Our Fondren Neighborhood Association Policies for Reports on Code Enforcement

When residents report potential code violations to the Code Enforcement Committee the Association will take steps to assist in the possible resolution of the reported violation. We recognize that some reports may not be of sufficient substance to report due to the limited resources of the Code Enforcement Division or Police Department of the City of Jackson.

1. We will research the Jackson Municipal Codes and the Jackson Zoning Codes for information pertaining to the reported potential violation.
2. The Committee will make a determination as to whether or not the potential violation is of sufficient substance to be reported to the Code Enforcement Division or Police Department of the City of Jackson. If it is considered to be of sufficient substance the Chairperson of the Committee will report the violation to the appropriate city authorities.
3. Where potential code violations have been reported to the city authorities, the Committee will follow up with them if it appears progress is not being made.
4. If the committee decides that the violation is not of sufficient substance for the committee to report to the Code Enforcement Division, the party reporting the violation (if known) will be provided the results of the research pertaining to the violation along with the name and address of the appropriate city official(s) to which the potential violation may be reported.
